### Asia-US Rate Hike Attempts Falter as Weak Demand and No Peak Season Bite

Ocean carriers are rolling out planned rate increases of \$1,000–3,000 per FEU (forty-foot equivalent unit) for Asia–US routes starting 1 September. However, these hikes have shown little success, with tanked demand and no real peak season dampening their impact.

- Lars Jensen, President of Vespucci Maritime, notes that rate hike attempts have been coming at a bi-weekly cadence but remain ineffective—pushing container rates to "unsustainably low" levels.
- An announcement by President Trump about investigating furniture imports—HS codes 9401 and 9403 accounted for ~6.9% of US imports in Q2—could provide a temporary lift if tariffs are imposed. Still, much of that furniture may have already been frontloaded prior to the tariff move.
- Peter Sand, Chief Analyst at Xeneta, confirms that carriers can drop worries about traditional peak-season charges- "there is no peak season in 2025." This, combined with growing capacity and muted demand, suggests spot rates will likely slide even further.
